## WHAT WILL I STUDY AND LEARN?

As well as giving you the opportunity to explore some fantastic literary texts, this fascinating course provides the opportunity to explore areas of language study only touched upon at GCSE level. Over the course of two years, you will develop both your analytical skills and your creative writing skills.

## HOW IS IT TAUGHT?

There is a strong emphasis on individual, independent study. During the course you should develop confidence in expressing your own opinions and ideas. Lessons are devoted to discussion and analysis of language, often led by students or in groups. Language changes daily and you will be encouraged to look at where our language has come from and where it is going. English Language and Literature teachers aim to communicate an enjoyment of the subject and related material.
