Dear Parent/Carer,


PARENTS' EVENING – THURSDAY 19 APRIL

Once you are logged in:

1. Click on 'Community' (on the blue bar across the top of the page) and then click 'Parents' evenings.'
2. Click on the Parents' Evening you want to book for and then click 'Book appointment.'

3. From the drop down menu select the teacher you want to see and then click the time slot. If a teacher already has another appointment they will show as 'Unavailable.'
4. Once you have made an appointment your 'Schedule' will be built and you can see the appointment(s) you have made.
 - a. You can add more appointments by clicking 'Book appointment'
 - b. You can use the 'Print schedule' button to print it out in a paper format to bring with you on the night.

NB: each of your child's teachers is listed. Therefore, in most subjects there are two or three teachers listed. Please feel free to make an appointment to see each teacher if you wish but there is often no need to do so because the department will be sharing information about student progress on each part of the course internally.

Students cannot book appointments themselves using Epraise; all appointments must be made using parent or teacher accounts. This means that you can, if you wish, send instructions with your child to make an appointment with a teacher. Once they have done this it appears on your account online.

I hope you find the new system a much more convenient and efficient way of organising appointments.

How to log in to Epraise

Go to www.epraise.co.uk, click Login, select our school **and select Parent**. Enter the email address that this email has been sent to.

If you have logged in before use the password that you set.

If you have not, leave the password field blank. You will set up your own password on the next screen.
