On Tuesday 2nd October, eight DSHS swimmers travelled to Malvern College to compete in the regional round of the ESSA Secondary Schools Team Championships. The two teams competed in the 4 x 50m freestyle and individual medley relays. Swimmers were racing to achieve their best times as their results will be ranked nationally with all competing teams. The top 30 teams in each event will qualify for the National finals in November.
